Rejuvenation of Ayad River

3920. SHRI ARJUN LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has allocated funds for the Conservation and Rejuvenation of Ayad River at Udaipur in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details of the funds allocated so far; and
- (c) the details of works for which this fund has been allocated?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (c) A project proposal for “Abatement of pollution, river flow channelization and river front beautification of Ayad River in Udaipur” was received in May, 2015 from Rajasthan Urban Infrastructure Finance Development Corporation Limited (RUIFDCO), for its consideration under National River Conservation Plan (NRCP). The proposal was sent to the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation on 4th September, 2015 for consideration, as river Ayad falls in the Ganga River Basin. Therefore, this Ministry could not consider the project proposal for allocating funds for the Conservation and Rejuvenation of Ayad River at Udaipur in Rajasthan under NRCP.
