- (a) whether the High Level Committee on the Status of Women constituted in 2012 has submitted its report to the Ministry in 2015 and if so , the details thereof;
- (b) whether the said report has been tabled in the Parliament; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, if not the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR)

(a) to (c): The High Level Committee (HLC) on the Status of Women was set up in 2012 by the Ministry of Women & Child Development, to undertake a comprehensive study to understand the status of women since 1989. The HLC examined the overall status of women including, inter-alia, the socio-economic, health and nutritional, legal and political status, disaggregated by rural/urban, economic and social position and wherever possible by minority status.
