#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE POST OF MESSENGER

### 4141. SHRI DIBYENDU ADHIKARI:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that recently 3700 Ph. D holders have applied for a messenger's post in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the minimum eligibility criteria laid down for the said post; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to fill the vacancies in various Government Departments in a time-bound manner?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): No such information has been received in the ministry in this regard.

(c): Recruitment under central government is primarily made by various recruitment agencies namely Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), Staff Selection Commission (SSC) and Railway Recruitment Board (RRB) etc. Besides these, many Ministries/Departments/PSUs have their own recruitment mechanism for certain posts in their domain. The filling up of posts is a continuous process depending on the vacancies arising across Ministries/Departments/PSUs during the years and action calendars of the recruiting agencies. The Government posts are regularly filled up in accordance with the prescribed recruitment rules.
