Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any agreement has been signed between the Railways and the State Bank of India regarding collection of cash received from sale of railway tickets at the station itself ;

(b) if so, the names of zones which have signed this agreement;

(c) the benefits likely to be accrued to the Railways from this agreement; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. At present, the following nine Zonal Railways have entered into an agreement with State Bank of India regarding collection of cash from Railway stations:

- (i) Eastern Railway
- (ii) East Central Railway
- (iii) Northern Railway
- (iv) North Central Railway
- (v) North Eastern Railway
- (vi) South Eastern Railway
- (vii) South East Central Railway
- (viii) South Western Railway
- (ix) West Central Railway

(c): The scheme has helped in faster remittance of station earnings in Government's bank account.

(d): Does not arise.
