Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether cancellation of various examination due to question paper leak puts pressure on the whole system and causes mental harassment and financial burden on candidates which adversely affects their preparation;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to consider the alternative of holding the examination in time by cancelling only that set of question paper which has got leaked instead of cancelling whole examination all together under National Testing Agency (NTA); and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. SATYA PAL SINGH)

(a) to (d): Cancellation of any examination due to question paper leak puts pressure on the system. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has reported that examination of Economics in Class XII had to be cancelled in 2018 due to leakage of question paper, and re-examination was held on the earliest available date. No financial burden was put on the candidates for reexamination. National Testing Agency (NTA) has informed that no instance of cancellation of exam due to leakage of question paper has occurred so far. However, the test will be re-conducted only in the paper in which the question paper leak is established.
