LED LIGHTS AT STATIONS

439. SHRIMATI VASANTHI M.:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Railways has decided to provide 100 percent LED lighting at all its stations and service buildings by the end of this financial year; and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether it is true that 100 per cent LED lighting across railway stations will improve the energy scenario and will reduce energy consumption by about 10 per cent of its non-traction energy consumption; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) Yes, Madam. All electrified Railway stations other than those in gauge conversion have already been provided with 100% LED luminaries by 30.03.2018.

Also, 99% of service buildings have been provided with 100% LED lights over Indian Railways.

(b) & (c) Yes, Madam. Use of 100% LED lights will reduce energy consumption for non-traction purpose by about 10%. This will be equivalent to about 240 million units of electricity per annum.
