#### **AMRUT SCHEME**

#### No. 4442. SHRI B.Y. RAGHAVENDRA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of AMRUT Scheme along with the names of cities identified under the said scheme since its inception including funds allocated/utilized there under, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Ministry is aware of the fact that the progress under the scheme is slow in Karnataka;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor along with the funds allocated and utilized and the State share released towards the scheme, city and component-wise with respect to Karnataka; and
- (d) the measures taken to improve the progress under this scheme along with the achievements thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

### THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

### (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a): The Government of India has launched the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation & Urban Transformation (AMRUT) on 25 June, 2015 in 500 Mission cities across the country. The Mission period is up to March, 2020. All Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) with a population of one lakh or more as per Census 2011, all other capital cities of States/Union Territories (UTs), all Heritage Cities under the Heritage City Development & Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY), identified cities on the stem of the main rivers, 10 cities from hill states, islands and tourist destinations (not more than one from each State) are taken up under AMRUT.

AMRUT Mission is a centrally sponsored scheme with a total outlay of rupees one lakh crore including a Central Assistance (CA) of Rs.50,000 crore spread over five years i.e. from FY 2015-2016 to FY 2019-2020. The balance share of Rs.50,000 crore has to come from States and ULBs.

The thrust areas of the Mission are water supply, sewerage &septage management, storm water drainage, green spaces & park and non-motorized urban transport. Besides creating infrastructure for basic amenities as above, the Mission also has a reform agenda spread over a set of 11 reforms comprising 54 milestones to be achieved by the States/ UTs over a period of four years. States/UTs are incentivized for implementing reforms.

Under AMRUT, individual projects are selected, appraised, approved and implemented by the concerned States/ UTs. The Government of India only approves State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) submitted by States/UTs and releases CA as per Mission guidelines.

List of AMRUT Cities/Towns is attached in the Annexure-I.The details of approved State Annual Action Plans, committed CA and funds released so far is at Annexure-II.

(b) & (c): The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has approved all the SAAPs for Rs. 4,953 crore for the State of Karnataka including committed CA of Rs. 2,319 crore. As per the information provided by the State Mission Director, Karnataka on AMRUT MIS portal, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved for projects costing Rs.5,241 crore. Of these, contracts have been awarded for 271 projects worth Rs.4,574 crore including 14 completed projects worth Rs.81 crore. State has taken up projects in excess of approved SAAPs for which entire additional expenditure shall be borne by the State.

The funds are not released city-wise or project-wise but are released to the States/UTs as per Mission guidelines. So far, Rs.1,419.92 crore have been released as Central Assistance to the State of Karnataka under AMRUT for project implementation, reform incentive, Administrative & Office Expenses (A&OE), formulation of GIS based Master Plans and for eligible projects under erstwhile Jawaharlal Nehru Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM). Details of CA released to Karnataka so far are as under:

So far, Utilisation Certificates have been received for Rs. 1,174.40 crore.

(d):In order to expedite the progress under the Mission, regular reviews are being conducted through video conferences, field visits, meetings of the State level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) and the Apex Committee meetings. In addition, letters are written regularly by the senior officers of the Ministry to the States/UTs.
