- (b) the names of States in which the Government has proposed to establish special centres for the benefit of Differently Abled people; and
- (c) the details of the targeted beneficiaries under the Economic Upliftment and Achievements of the Government during the last three years?

(a): The Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Caste Sub Plan is released to the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations based on the Budgetary Allocation. The Budget Estimates and expenditure under the scheme during the last three years are as follows:
