FUNCTIONING OF NIs, CRCs AND DDRCs

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of National Institutes (NIs), Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) and District Disability Rehabilitation Centres (DDRCs) functioning in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has provided grants-in-aid to such centres during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefore, State-wise;
- (d) whether these centres have failed to provide requisite help to disabled persons and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has reviewed the working of such centres during the said period; and
- (f) if so, the details and outcome thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

- (a) There are eight National Institutes (NIs) and sixteen Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) functioning in the country. Also, across the country, 310 districts have been identified and approved for setting up of District Disability Rehabilitation Centres (DDRCs). The State-wise details of NIs, CRCs and (DDRCs) are at Annexure-I.
- (b) & (c) The details of funds released to NIs and CRCs during last three years and current year are given at **Annexure-II**. State wise and year wise funds released to DDRCs for the last three years & current year are given at **Annexure III**.
- (d) No such instances have come to notice of this Department so far.
- (e) & (f) DDRCs are to be run under the supervision of a District Management Team headed by District Collector which also includes various welfare authorities of State Govt.

Government reviews the functioning of the NIs and CRCs regularly by taking Review Meetings. Other than that, performances of the NIs/CRCs are also monitored by the Executive Council and General Council of the respective National Institute. As a result, services and infrastructure of NIs/CRCs/DDRCs have increased significantly.
