(e) whether this initiative has been taken up under the National Mission for Safety of Women and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): Yes, Madam. As a part of the initiatives for Safety of Women, the Ministry of Home Affairs has launched the National Database on Sexual Offenders (NDSO) on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018. This online facility is exclusively for the use of law enforcement agencies having access to Inter- operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS). As on 28<sup>th</sup> December 2018, the NDSO has 4,93,778 records of offenders involved in sexual offences like rape, gang rape, eve teasing, stalking, child abuse etc.
