- (a) whether the Government will introduce any policy for scrapping of old cars and other transport vehicles;
- (b) whether under such schemes the Government shall set up scrapping centres itself or give licenses to private entities;

- (d) if not, the steps proposed to be taken to protect the environment during the scrapping process?
