# **Impact of R.O. Water Purifiers**

#### **510. SHRI MALYADRI SRIRAM:**

(a) whether minerals/vitamins essential for human body are also extracted from water by R.O. system causing several health issues;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether any concrete remedial steps have been taken or proposes to be taken by the Government to address the problem; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

(a) to (d) The Ministry has issued guidelines on 30-Oct-2015 with regard to the Bureau of Indian Standards' standard for reverse osmosis based point-of-use systems (BIS 16240: 2015) and recommended to use RO technology only when the total dissolved solids in drinking water sources is very high.

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
