**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 156 BY SHRIMATI BUTTA RENUKA TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 13.02.2019 REGARDING NEW TRAINS.**

**(a): Introduction of new trains is an ongoing process over Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, availability of resources, traffic justification etc. However, Indian Railways does not operate trains on State-wise basis as Railways cut-across State boundaries. During the last four years i.e. from 2014-15 to 2017-18, Indian Railways have introduced 751 train services (in single), of these, 38 train services (19 pairs) serve the stations located in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Further, during 2018-19, 4 train services (2 pairs) have been introduced serving the stations located in the State of Andhra Pradesh.**

**(b): State-wise statistics of number of passengers is not maintained on Indian Railways.**
