**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) the average revenue generated and foreign exchange earned from tourism during the last three years;**
- (b) the details of the ongoing schemes for the development and promotion of tourism and the number of tourism infrastructure projects prioritised/sanctioned during the above period, State/ UT-wise, particularly in Gujarat;**
- (c) whether the Government has received proposals from various States for the development and promotion of tourism and allocation of funds therefor;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof indicating the number of such proposals received and the number of projects sanctioned and funds allocated, State-wise; and**
- (e) whether the Government proposes to increase allocation of funds for tourism infrastructure, promotion, publicity of tourist destinations and products in the domestic and international markets and if so, the details thereof?**

**(a): The estimated foreign exchange earnings (FEEs) through tourism in India during 2015, 2016 and 2017 were Rs.134844 crore, Rs.154146 crore and Rs.177874 crore, respectively. Ministry of Tourism does not compile the information on revenue generated by tourism in the country.**

**(b) to (d): Development and promotion of tourist destinations including identification of places of tourist interest is primarily the responsibility of State Governments/ Union Territory (UT) Administrations. However, Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance under its two flagship schemes namely 'Swadesh Darshan (SD)' and 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' for the development of tourism related infrastructure and facilities to promote tourism in the country.**

**Submission of projects by the State Governments/ Union Territories under the schemes is a continuous process. The projects under the schemes are identified for development in consultation with the State Governments/ UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.**

**The details of projects sanctioned to States / UTs including Gujarat under SD and PRASHAD schemes are given at Annexure - I and Annexure - II respectively.**

**(e): The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India, as part of its on-going activities, releases media campaigns in the print, electronic, online and outdoor media in the international and domestic markets to promote various tourism destinations and products of the country. The expenditure on campaigns released in the international and domestic markets is incurred from funds allocated under the heads of "Restructured Overseas Promotion and Publicity including Marketing Development Assistance (OPMD)" and "Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH)" respectively.**

**The Budget Estimate (BE) allocated for creation of tourism infrastructure and promotion of tourism to different schemes of the Ministry during the last three years are as below:**
