PROMOTION OF FDI

1. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the proposals received and sanctioned/ not sanctioned for the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) by the foreign investment promotion board and the actual flow of FDI arrived in the country in various areas along with from China during each year of the last three years and the current year, country wise;
- (b) the area-wise details of the utilisation of FDI in various areas along with Railway and Defence sectors during the said period;
- (c) the highest contributor country of foreign investment in India and the areas in the country that get benefitted most by FDI in the country;
- (d) the details of the FDI proposals lying pending along with the reasons for their pending and the measures taken by the Government for their speedy disposal; and
- (e) the measures taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to increase the investment in the country?

- (a): Foreign Investment Promotion Board (FIPB) had been abolished with effect from 24.05.2017. Thereafter, the work granting government approval of foreign investment under the extant FDI Policy has been entrusted to the concerned Administrative Ministries/Departments. Since then up to 31.12.2018, 283 proposals have been received including those which were not disposed of by erstwhile FIPB. Out of these, 120 proposals have been approved, 117 have been closed/rejected and 46 are under consideration in various Ministries/Departments.

The Financial Year wise details of FDI inflow reported during the last 3 year and current year is at Annexure-I. Country wise details (including from China) are available for FDI equity inflow only, which are placed at Annexure –II.

- (b):** The area wise details of the utilisation of FDI are not centrally maintained. However, the sector wise details of FDI equity inflow (including for Railway and Defence) are placed at Annexure-III.
- (c):** The highest contributor country of Foreign Investment reported through FDI Equity Inflow for the period April, 2000 to June, 2018 is 'Mauritius'. Further, 'Service Sector' has attracted highest investment reported through FDI equity inflow of US \$68.62 Billion during the period April, 2000 to June, 2018.
- (d):** Filing of FDI proposals and disposal thereof is a continuous process. Decisions on all FDI proposals are taken after completion of all the necessary documents. As on 31st December 2018, 47 FDI proposals are under consideration at various stages in the concerned Administrative Ministries/Departments.

A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) has been devised for processing FDI proposals. As per SOP, 8 to 10 weeks' time has been fixed for decision on the proposals, excluding the time taken by applicants in removing deficiencies in the proposals/supplying additional information as may be required by the Competent Authority. Further, to ensure timely disposal of FDI proposals, periodic review is undertaken by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade with other stakeholder Ministries/Departments.

- (e):** To promote Foreign Direct Investment(FDI), the Government has put in place an investor-friendly policy, wherein except for a small negative list, most sectors are open for 100% FDI under the Automatic route. Further, the policy on FDI is reviewed on an ongoing basis, to ensure that India remains attractive & investor friendly destination. Changes are made in the policy after having intensive consultations with stakeholders including apex industry chambers, associations, representatives of industries/groups and other organizations taking into consideration their views/comments
