INCREASE IN NUMBER OF BILLIONAIRES

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the number of billionaires has been continuously increasing from the year 2000-01 to till date;
- (b) if so, the number of the billionaires in the country during the said period and as on date, year-wise; and
- (c) the value of the total assets of the said billionaires during the said period?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) There is no official / uniform definition of classification of a person as 'billionaire'. As per the information available with Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT), the number of individuals disclosing a gross total income of more than Rs.100 crore (one billion rupees) in a year in his / her return of income filed with the Income Tax Department since the Assessment Year 2013-14 to Assessment Year 2017-18 are given in the table below. Data on such individuals from 2000-01 to 2012-13 is not centrally available.

Table: Number of individuals disclosing a gross total income of more than Rs.100 crorein a year in his / her return of income filed with the Income Tax Department

(c) Government does not maintain information on value of total assets of individual tax payers; hence, any information on assets of billionaires / rich people of the country is not available.
