## UPGRADING OF HEALTH SUB-CENTRES INTO HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTRES

## 1071. SHRI BALABHADRA MAJHI: SHRI J.J.T. NATTERJEE:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is in the process of upgrading Health Sub-Centres (HSC) into Health and Wellness Centres (HWC), if so, the number of such HSCs upgraded in HWCs till date, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the human resources proposed at each HWC along with the number of human resources posted at such HWCs-State/UT wise;
- (c) whether there are any gaps in the human resources proposed at HWC and actual availability, if so, the details and reasons therefor along with the initiatives taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether there is any specific outcome/output of converting HSC into HWC, if so, the details thereof, State/UT wise; and
- (e) the number of HWCs functional in tribal areas of Odisha, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Uttarakhand?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a): As a part of Ayushman Bharat, Health Sub-Centres (HSC) and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) are to be transformed into Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs). The State/UT wise details of HSCs upgraded as HWCs as on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 are at Annexure-I.
- (b) & (c): As per the Ayushman Bharat Operational Guidelines for Comprehensive Primary Health Care through Health and Wellness Centres- the HWC at the Sub Health Centre level comprises of at least three service providers:
  - a. One Mid-Level Health Provider (MLHP),
  - b. Two, Multi-Purpose Workers (two females or one male and one female)
  - c. Team of ASHAs at the norm of one ASHA per 1000 population (in tribal, hilly and desert areas, norm relaxed to one ASHA per habitation).

"Public Health and Hospitals" being a State subject, the primary responsibility of provision of human resource in public health facilities including HWC is that of respective State Government. The state/UT wise details of Human Resource posting/available at HSC-HWCs on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 are at Annexure-II.

- (d): As per Ayushaman Bharat Operational Guidelines for Comprehensive Primary Health Care through HWCs, the outcomes of converting SHC to HWC are as below:
  - **Improved population coverage:** Active empanelment and HWC database will improve the population coverage. The HWC database would enable HWC staff to monitor and identify the left out population and improve coverage of national health programmes.
  - Reduced out of pocket expenditure and catastrophic health expenditure: Improved access to expanded services closer to the community, assured availability of medicines and diagnostic services and linkages for care coordination with Medical Officers/specialists across levels of care will reduce financial hardships faced by community.
  - **Risk factor mitigation**: Health promotion efforts by primary health care team would support in addressing the risk factors for diseases.
  - Decongestion of secondary and tertiary health facilities: A strong network of HWCs at the sub district level would facilitate resolving more cases at primary level and reduce overcrowding at secondary and tertiary facilities for follow up cases as well as serve a gate keeping function to higher-level facilities.

State/UT wise details of screening done at HSC upgraded to HWCs for diabetes, hypertension, oral cancer & Breast cancer on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 are at Annexure-III.

(e): Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh have prioritized operationalization of PHC as HWCs for FY 2018-19. Thus, SHCs as HWCs would be operationalized in FY 2019-20. Details of HWCs at HSCs on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 in districts of Odisha and Uttarakhand along with percentage of ST population in the district as per Census 2011is at Annexure-IV.
