- (a) the number of new AIIMS sanctioned during the last five years and the amount of funds spent/proposed to be spent in this regard, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has sanctioned a proposal for setting up new AIIMS in various parts of the country including at Mahoba in Bundelkhand;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the six AIIMS initially set up by the Government have started working in full swing, if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps being taken by the Government for the expansion of healthcare facilities in Mahoba, Hamirpur and Tindwari of Uttar Pradesh?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a): Government has announced setting up of 15 new AIIMS during the last five years. Out of which, Union Cabinet has approved setting up of 13 new AIIMS in the country. Details of the sanctioned fund for each new AIIMS can be seen at Annexure.
- (b) & (c): No. There is no proposal for setting up new AIIMS in Mahoba in Bundelkhand. However, two new AIIMS in Rae Bareli and Gorakhpur have been approved to be set up in the State of Uttar Pradesh.
- (d): The six AIIMS initially set up by the Government have started working in full swing.
- (e): There is no proposal for expansion of healthcare facilities in Mahoba, Hamirpur and Tindwari of Uttar Pradesh.
