VACANT POSTS IN VARIOUS LABOUR COURTS AND TRIBUNALS

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether some posts of presiding officers and judges are lying vacant in various Labour Courts and Tribunals in the country including North East States;
- (b)if so, the details thereof; and
- (c)the time by which these posts are likely to be filled up?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The posts of Presiding Officer in CGIT-cum-LCs at Kanpur, Asansol, Chandigarh-I and in National Industrial Tribunal (NIT) Mumbai-I are lying vacant. The process for filling up the post of Presiding Officer at these CGITs/NIT has already been initiated by the Ministry.
