DEVELOPMENT OF AREA AROUND THE STATUE OF UNITY

1256. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM: SHRI FEROZE VARUN GANDHI:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the tourism has increased substantially in the area after the Statue of Unity has been opened for visitors and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the revenue generated till now from visitors to the Statue of Unity;
- (c) whether the Government plans to develop the area around the Statue to increase employment and tourism in the surrounding area and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the financial burden is to be shared between the State and the Union Government for the coming years upto 2021; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K.J. ALPHONS)

(a): Yes, Madam. As per the information provided by Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Rashtriya Ekta Trust, the number of tourists who visited the Statue of Unity at Kevadia in 3 months from November, 2018 to January, 2019 was 7,81,349 as against yearly average of 8,22,009 tourists visiting Sardar Sarovar Dam at Kevadia in the last five years.

(b): Revenue generated from visitors to Statue of Unity from November, 2018 to January, 2019 is Rs.19.47 crore.

(c): It has been decided to develop tourism related activities such as the following in the area:

- Jungle Safari
- Amusement Park, Adventure & Eco-tourism Park
- Children's Nutrition Park
- Boating from Shreshtha Bharat Bhavan to Statue of Unity
- Food Court & Mirror Maze
- Cactus Garden
- (d): No, Madam.
- (e): Does not arise.
