SETTING UP OF JAIN PILGRIMAGE CIRCUIT

†1273. SHRI MUKESH RAJPUT:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up Jain pilgrimage circuit;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the international Buddhist pilgrimage site sankisa has been included/ proposed to be included in the Buddhist circuit and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K.J. ALPHONS)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism, under the scheme of Swadesh Darshan, is developing theme-based tourism circuits in the country. Tirthankar and Buddhist Circuits are among the fifteen thematic circuits identified for development under the Scheme.

Under Tirthankar Circuit, the Ministry has sanctioned the project for Development of Vaishali- Arrah- Masad- Patna- Rajgir-Pawapuri- Champapuri in Bihar in the year 2016-17 for Rs.52.39 crore.

All sites in the country related to Buddhism including Sankisa are covered under the Buddhist Circuit for development.
