Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has not been able to develop rural tourism in the country to the desired extent though the country has a huge potential, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) the objectives and the success achieved since the inception of Rural Tourism Scheme;
- (c) the criteria adopted for providing Central Financial Assistance (CFA) thereunder for development of rural sites;
- (d) the details of the funds sanctioned/released and utilised for Rural Tourism Projects out of the proposals received during each of the last three years and the current year indicating the status of completed projects, State/UT-wise;
- (e) whether problems are being faced by the Government in execution of such projects and if so, the details thereof along with the measures taken by the Government to remove such problems/obstacles; and
- (f) the further measures taken by the Government to focus on rural tourism to generate employment, income and promoting new destinations by exhibiting ancient heritage and culture of the hills along with providing connectivity to rural areas?

(a) to (f): The Ministry of Tourism has launched the Swadesh Darshan Scheme for Integrated Development of theme-based Tourist Circuits for

development of tourism infrastructure including last mile connectivity in the country. Recognizing the potential of rural tourism in the country, the Ministry has identified Rural Circuit as one of thematic circuits identified for development under this scheme and is aimed at leveraging tourism as a force multiplier for revitalizing the rural economy and for giving both domestic and international tourists a glimpse of the rural aspect of the country.

The projects for development of tourism related infrastructure, including rural tourism projects/proposals, are identified for development under the circuit in consultation with the State Governments/UTs and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence of scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.

Based on the above criteria, the Ministry has sanctioned following projects for development of Rural Circuits under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme which are under different stages of implementation:
