(a) to (d) Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have informed that in order to enhance the average hard currency float available on relatively favourable terms, comprising payable for crude purchases, the Reserve Bank of India vide circular dated 3rd October, 2018 has permitted OMCs to raise External Commercial Borrowing (ECB) for working capital purposes with minimum average maturity period of 3/5 years from all recognized lenders under the automatic route with an overall ceiling of US\$ 10 billion equivalent. Further, the individual limit of US\$ 750 million and mandatory hedging requirement have also been waived, subject to OMCs having Board approved forex mark-to- market procedure and prudent risk management policy.
