Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has received a proposal from State Government of Kerala to include maximum institutions from the State for the assistance under the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) Phase-III project;
- (b) if so, the status of the proposal; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Union Government as the Kerala institutions have made significant improvement in the quality of education from the first two phase of TEQIP?

(a) to (c): National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU) received proposal from the Government of Kerala for inclusion of maximum institutions from the State. However, only one institute from Kerala, viz. School of Engineering, Cochin University of Science & Technology, which is autonomous and got No Objection Certificate (NOC) from State Government, could fulfill the requirements for participation in Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) phase-III and has been included.
