Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the four militants killed by security forces at Khiram Srigufara in South Kashmir were from the outfit, Islamic State Jammu and Kashmir;
- (b) whether it is also true that the Islamic State Jammu and Kashmir has no organisation chord with the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria;
- (c) whether a number of Kashmiri Youths, albeit in small number as of now are joining the outfit through self proclamation;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) As per reports, no specific connection has surfaced between the outfit ISJK and the groups operating in Iraq and Syria.

It has been reported that 7 local youths have joined ISJK through self proclamation. Out of these 4 terrorists were neutralized on 22.06.2018 at Khiram Srigufawara, Anantnag, 2 were arrested and 1 is presently active in the valley.
