METRO RAIL FACILITY IN BANGALORE

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has received any proposal from Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. (BMRCL) seeking Central assistance to partly fund its Nagawara to Kempegowda International Airport (KIA) and the Outer Ring Road (ORR) routes;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has received the detailed project report for KIA link by BMRCL;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) whether the Government has approved the said proposal and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) Government of Karnataka had submitted the proposals of Metro Rails from Central Silk Board to K.R. Puram on Outer Ring Road (ORR) (Phase-2A) and Nagawara to Kempegowda International Airport (KIA) (Phase-2B) in December, 2017 and January 2018 respectively.

The above proposals were for central financial assistance in the form of grant of Rs. 420.20 crore out of the estimated cost of Rs. 4,202 crore and Rs. 500 crore out of the estimated cost of Rs.5,950 crore for Phase-2A and 2B respectively.

Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. (BMRCL) has informed that Government of Karnataka (GoK) has now decided to implement Bangalore Metro Phase-2A and Phase-2B with revised scope and alignment on equal equity sharing model.

(c) The revised Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for Phase 2A and 2B of Bangalore Metro Rail Project have not been received in this Ministry.
