DEVELOPMENT OF MANGO CULTIVATION

1530. SHRIMATI MAUSAM NOOR:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps and the schemes implemented or proposed to be implemented for the development of mango cultivation in the country and the details thereof including funds allocated for the sector;
- (b) the details of various schemes and programmes intended for the welfare of small-scale and mid-size farmers engaged in mango cultivation;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to launch any special scheme for the promotion of cost effective and innovative mango cultivation in the country;
- (d) whether there are any proposals made by agricultural universities in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), a centrally sponsored scheme is implemented for the holistic development of horticulture sector in the country covering fruits (including mango), vegetables, root and tuber crops, mushrooms, spices, flowers, aromatic plants, coconut, cashew & coca and through various interventions.

Details of State-wise funds allocated under MIDH during the last three years and current year is at Annexure.

(c) to (e): Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) institutes like Central Institute for Subtropical Horticulture (CISH) Lucknow and Indian Institute of Horticultural Research (IIHR), Bengaluru are engaged in development of new technologies and varieties which has resulted in innovated mango cultivated like High Density Plantation (HDP).

Further, technologies for canopy management and varieties having tolerance to various adverse conditions are being promoted under MIDH and Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) scheme to enhance to productivity and cost effectiveness of mango cultivation.
