# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.1545 TO BE ANSWERED ON FEBRUARY 12, 2019

### **EXPENDITURE ON SMART CITIES**

### No. 1545. SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the expenditure incurred by the Government for establishing smart cities in the country including Bihar along with the progress made in the development of each smart city and the expected time frame for completion;
- (b) whether the funds provided /being provided is sufficient to convert the existing cities into smart cities and if not, the steps taken/being taken in this regard;
- (c) the name of private companies and foreign companies which have shown interest in smart cities project and the name of the cities to which foreign assistance is likely to be provided; and
- (d) whether the Government has received any additional proposal from the State of Bihar to be included under the Smart City Mission and if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

- (a) & (b) 100 smart cities have been selected for development as Smart cities in four rounds as follows:
  - 20 Smart Cities in Round 1 in January 2016
  - 13 Smart Cities in Fast Track Round 2 in May 2016
  - 27 Smart Cities in Round 2 in September 2016.
  - 30 Smart Cities in Round 3 in June 2017 and
  - 10 Smart Cities in Round 4 (9 in January 2018 and 1 in June 2018).

A total of 5,151 projects at an estimated cost of Rs. 2,05,018 crores have been included by the 100 cities in their Smart City Proposals. As per Smart Cities Mission Statement and Guidelines, the Central Government proposes to give financial support to the extent of Rs. 48,000 crores over the Mission period or 23% of the estimated cost of projects. An equal amount, on a matching basis, is to be provided by the State/Urban Local Body (ULB). Apart from these, around Rs. 42,028 crores (21%) is expected from convergence with other Missions, Rs. 41,022 crores (20%) from Public Private Partnerships (PPPs), around Rs. 9,843 crores (5%) from loans, and remaining from other sources.

Against Rs. 16,604.20 crore allocated in the budget for Smart Cities Mission since 2015-16, an amount of Rs. 15,536 crore has so far been released by Government of India to States for Smart Cities.

The implementation of the Smart Cities Mission is being done by a city-level Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV). All 100 cities have incorporated Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) and appointed Project Management Consultants (PMCs). As on January 25, 2019, 2,748 projects worth Rs. 1,04,964 crore have been tendered, of which 2,032 projects worth Rs. 62,295 crore are under implementation/have been completed.

The timeline for completion of projects by cities is five years from the date of their selection as Smart cities.

City-wise details of funds released and progress of projects in Smart cities is at Annexure.

(c) At the National level, Memorada of Understanding (MoUs) / Agreements for Technical Assistance have been executed with Department for International Development (DFID), United Kingdom and GIZ, Germany separately. Under the Climate Smart Cities project, GIZ shall be assisting the cities of Kochi Coimbatore and Bhubaneshwar. An MoU has also been signed with Netherlands for Technical Assistance to the Smart cities of Agra, Dharamshala and Karnal. At the State level, MoUs/ Agreements for Technical Assistance have been executed between United States Trade and Development Agency (USTDA) & State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan and between French Development Agency (AFD) and Union Territories of Chandigarh, Puducherry and State Government of Maharashtra. **A Credit Facility** Agreement for loan of EUR 100 million and Grant Financing Agreement of EUR 6 million has been executed with AFD for funding of upto 15 innovative Smart City Projects selected through a Challenge Process from across the country. There is a provision for global expertise to be provided during the design and implementation phases of these Projects.

In addition, various other countries, namely, Spain, Canada, Germany, Singapore, South Korea and Japan have also shown interest in participating in the development of Smart Cities.

The implementation of the Smart Cities Mission is being done by a city-level Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV). Several private companies like Eptisa, Price Water house Coopers, Grant Thornton, Ernst and Young, KPMG etc. have been appointed as Project Management Consultants (PMCs) by SPVs. Private companies are also expressing interest in various projects tendered by SPVs and executing them on award of work.
