- (a) whether the number of agricultural colleges in the country is much lesser as compared to number of engineering/medical colleges, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) the number of agricultural colleges at present in each State/UT and the number of such colleges proposed to be opened in the next one year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Union Government has received several proposals from various States including Maharashtra for setting up of Agricultural Universities/Colleges, if so, the details thereof including the number of proposals received during the last two years and the current year, State/UT-wise along with the action taken thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to set up an All India Body on the lines of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)/Medical Council of India (MCI) for agricultural colleges to monitor and better regulate their functioning, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to ensure that agricultural colleges are given equal importance?

Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) aid, support and strengthen agricultural education in the country.

- (d) Yes, Madam. A Draft Bill on National Council for Higher Agricultural Education (NCHAE) to regulate Higher Agricultural Education in India is under consideration with the Department.

Every state agricultural university is being given equal opportunity to apply, successfully compete and get financial support for strengthening agricultural education through the National Agricultural Higher Education Project.
