(a) & (b): Under the Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana framework, the development of Gram Panchayats is envisaged through convergence and implementation of existing Government Schemes and Programmes under the administrative control of respective Ministries without allocating additional funds.

However, under the Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) scheme implemented under Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), as many as 286 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) have imparted training to 96744 farmers by organizing 3442 training programmes in the villages under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yoana during the last two years. The State/UT-wise details of funds spent by KVKs for training purpose under this programme during the last two years (2016-17 & 2017-18) are given in the **Annexure**.
