### DEVELOPMENT OF TOURIST PLACES IN MADHYA PRADESH AND CHHATTISGARH

#### †157. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has provided any financial assistance to Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh for development of existing and new tourist places and organizing festivals during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, year-wise;
- (c) the year-wise details of the steps taken or schemes formulated by the Government for promotion of tourist places located in Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh for attracting/encouraging tourists;
- (d) the details of the proposals received from Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh in this regard; and
- (e) the reasons for pendency of the proposals received?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K.J. ALPHONS)

- (a) to (e): Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance to State Governments/Union Territory Administrations including the States of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh under its various Schemes:
  - i) Swadesh Darshan Scheme for development of theme based tourism circuits.

- ii) National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) Scheme for integrated development of identified pilgrimage and heritage destinations.
- iii) Financial Assistance to State Government/Union Territory Administrations for Organizing Fair and Festivals and Tourism related Events.

Ministry of Tourism promotes various tourism sites and products of different States/Union Territories including those in the States of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh in the domestic and international markets through media campaigns and activities undertaken by Indiatourism domestic and overseas offices.

Submission of project proposals by the State Governments/UT Administrations under the above schemes is a continuous process. The projects for development are identified in consultation with the State Governments/UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.

Details of projects sanctioned to the State Governments of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh under the above schemes during the last three years and current year is given at Annexure.
