(a) whether the Government has received Detailed Project Report with regard to setting up of Greyhounds Training Centre in Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof;

(b) the estimated cost when it was conceived and the cost overrun, if any, of this project;

(c) the reasons for delay in allocating and releasing the grants; and

(d) the time by which the Government is likely to set up the Centre and start giving training to personnel?

(a): Government of Andhra Pradesh submitted a Detailed Project Report

(DPR) in August, 2016 to set up Greyhounds Training Centre in Andhra

Pradesh

(b) to (d): Government has already approved the proposal for setting up of State-of-the-art Greyhounds Training Centre in Andhra Pradesh at a cost of Rs. 219.16 crore in April, 2018. The details of possession of encumbrance free land along with necessary clearances for setting-up of the said Centre have been requested from the Government of Andhra Pradesh before funds are released. The estimated time for completion of the project is three years from the date of commencement.
