- (a) whether the National Institute of Science, Bangalore has been recognized in the top 10 science research institutes in the world and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the institute has demanded a financial aid to the tune of crores of rupees for development of indigenous nano technology and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government to provide financial assistance to this institute?

- (a) to (c):** There is no Institute named as National Institute of Science in Bangalore under Government of India. There is an Indian Institute of Science (IISc) at Bangalore notified as an Institute of Eminence (IoE) ranked 170 in the QS World University Ranking 2019. A total amount of Rs. 17.00 crore has been released to IISc Bangalore for Centre for Nano Science & Engineering (CeNSE) consisting of Rs. 5.00 crore in 2017-18 and Rs. 12.00 crore so far in 2018-19.
