(a)to(c) A request from Government of Karnataka regarding recognition of Lingayats and Veerashavias who follow Basavanna's philosophy and teaching, as a religious minority was received in this Ministry. The same was examined in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs and National Commission for Minorities (NCM). Based on the views received from Ministry of Home Affairs & NCM, the request of Government of Karnataka was not acceded to and decision has been communicated to the Government of Karnataka.
