#### **SETTING UP OF NEW DIVISIONS**

#### **1716. SHRI BALABHADRA MAJHI:**

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways is considering extension of the jurisdiction of East Coast Railway to include Banspani- Padapahar, Rupsa-Bangriposi and Bhadrak-Laxmannath Road, Bondamunda-Barbil-Barsuan, Bondamunda-Rourkela-Jharsuguda-Himgiri sections of SER and SECR and to set up New Railway Divisions with headquarters at Jajpur-Keonjhar Road, Rourkela and Rayagada;

- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

The proposal for creation of new Divisions with headquarters at Jajpur-Keonjhar Road, Rourkela and Rayagada when examined from these aspects, has not been found feasible.
