HIGH SPEED RAIL CORRIDOR

1731. SHRI R.P. MARUTHARAJAA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government is going to start a high speed rail corridor from Chennai to Coimbatore;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the said corridor is planned to pass through Salam also;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the amount of expenditure likely to be incurred on this corridor and the time by which it is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (e): No, Madam. There is no plan to start a High Speed Rail Corridor for Chennai to Coimbatore at present. Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Project (MAHSR) is the only High Speed Corridor sanctioned on date in the country.
