FACILITIES AT JALORE STATION

†1807. SHRI DEVJI M. PATEL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to complete other related infrastructure including drinking water, passenger shed, display board, construction of separate toilet for women, air-conditioned waiting room and hotel for the development of Jalore railway station within the stipulated time period;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the budget provided for this project;**
- (c) the reasons for delay in providing basic infrastructure at Jalore railway station as per model station; and**
- (d) the total budgetary allocation made along with the total funds utilized on providing facility to the citizens at Jalore railway station during the last three years?**

(a) to (c): Jalore is a Non-Suburban Grade (NSG)-5 category station dealing with 722 passengers on an average per day. All minimum essential amenities have been provided at this station as per norms. However, upgradation of amenities at station is a continuous and on-going process and works in this regard are undertaken depending upon need, volume of the passenger traffic and inter-se priority subject to availability of funds.
