#### **CYBER CRIME INVESTIGATIONS**

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to upgrade the quality of cyber crime investigations in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has crafted a special programme for the judicial officers, prosecutors and police officers to help them study significant issues relating to various cyber crime cases and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has urged the State Governments to spread awareness on cases like "phone fraud" and other such crimes;
- (d) if so, the response of the State Governments thereto;
- (e) whether the Government is providing special financial aid to train police officers, prosecutors and judicial officers in cyber crime awareness programme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof along with the other steps taken or proposed to be taken to deal with the cyber crimes?

(a) to (f): The Ministry of Home Affairs is implementing two schemes, namely Cyber Crime Prevention against Women and Children (CCPWC) & Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) to strengthen mechanism to deal with cyber crime in the country by setting up online cybercrime reporting platform; national cyber forensic laboratory; training of Police Officers, Judicial Officers & Prosecutors; cybercrime awareness activities; etc. Standardized training programs have been prepared for training of Law Enforcement Agencies(LEAs), Public Prosecutors and Judicial Officers. Handbook on Cyber Safety for Adolescents/Students has been released and cyber crime awareness campaign has been launched through twitter handle (@CyberDost) and radio across the country. Financial assistance has been provided to all States/UTs for capacity building of Police Officers, Judicial Officers & Prosecutors in cyber domain. This Ministry has issued advisories on cyber crime prevention and control and steps to check phone frauds which are available on www.mha.gov.in.

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
