382. SHRI B. SENGUTTUVAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that every year, hundreds of explosions caused by Improvised Explosive Devices (IED) and Explosive Remnants of War (ERW) leave a number of people disabled for life;

(b) if so, the number of persons rendered disabled due to IED and ERW explosions during the three years;

(c) whether the Government is aware that most villages along the Western border are planted with landmines that go off unexpectedly causing disability to the inhabitants;

(d) whether the Government has any special programme or financial package for the person affected by the unexpected explosions of IED and ERW; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?
