AGRICULTURAL PATENTS

397. SHRI J.J.T. NATTERJEE:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि और किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any mechanism to support farmers for filing patents in connection with agriculture;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is promoting Geographical Indication (GI) tag for various agri produce;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the list of such GI tagged agri produce, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) While plant varieties are a prominent input technology of agriculture, they cannot be patented in India. However, the Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority established by Central Government in the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, under Section 3 of *Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights* Act (2001) grants intellectual property rights to plant breeders' and farmers' (individuals or community) on the plant varieties developed by them.

On receipt of an application for registration of a plant variety, the same is examined and Distinctness, Uniform and Stability (DUS) testing is conducted on field and after analyzing the DUS test report the same is advertised in the Plant Variety Journal inviting oppositions and if the opposition filed is rejected or no opposition is filed then registration certificate is granted. The period of protection is 15 years in case of field crops and 18 years in case of trees and vines.

Further, the National Innovation Foundation (NIF), Autonomous Body of Department of Science & Technology, Govt of India files patents in the name of farmers who develop agricultural tools, machines and herbal formulations for agricultural use. NIF also files application under Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Act, 2001 for the registration of plant varieties developed by farmers.

- (c) Yes, Madam.
- (d) As per the Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection) Act, 1999, goods with respect to which Geographical Indications (GIs) are registered means any agricultural, natural or manufactured goods or any goods of handicrafts or of industry and includes food stuff. The Government has undertaken several steps for promotion of Indian products registered as GIs. These include, *inter-alia*, participation in trade fairs and other events to promote and create awareness on GIs and increase the sales of GI products, promotion of GIs through social media, involving State Governments and Union Territory Administration and other relevant organisations for facilitation of GI producers. Agricultural GIs are also included in these promotional activities.
