- (a) whether the Government is implementing any scheme called NFSM Rice Programme (NFSM-RP), if so, the details thereof including the objectives and salient features thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has included any district in the State of Kerala under the NFSM-RP, if so, the details thereof including the names of districts in Kerala covered under the NFSM-RP; and
- (c) whether the Government has any record regarding the funds spent for Kerala during each of the last three years under the NFSM-RP and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. For increasing the production and productivity of rice in the country, the Government has been implementing National Food Security Mission-Rice (NFSM-Rice) programme. The objectives of the programme is to increase the production of rice through area expansion and productivity enhancement in a sustainable manner in the identified districts of the country, restoring soil fertility and productivity at the individual farm level; and enhancing farm level economy (i.e. farm profits) to restore confidence amongst the farmers. At present, the NFSM-Rice programme is being implemented in 194 identified districts of 25 States including Kerala. Palakkad district of Kerala is covered under NFSM-Rice. The allocation of funds to Kerala State under NFSM-Rice programme for last three years is as under:
