#### PROCUREMENT OF FOODGRAINS

#### 433. SHRI RAJU SHETTY:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether food items like wheat, arhar were procured to give relief to the farmers when market rate were fallen to assure Minimum Support Price during last three four years;
- (b) if so, the details of the quantum of these food items purchased from farmers, State-wise;
- (c) whether any irregularity was noticed during purchase, transport and storage of these commodities;
- (d) whether the storage capacity for surplus grains area available in the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the manner in which the Government will tackle such situation in future?

### ANSWER

### MINISTER OF STATE FOR CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI C. R. CHAUDHARY)

- (a) & (b): Details of wheat and Arhar (Tur) procured by Government agencies at Minimum Support Price from farmers during last three year and current year are at Annexure-I and II respectively.
- (c): Immediate action is taken by the State Governments or Food Corporation of India (FCI), as the case may be, if any instance of irregularity is noticed or reported.
- (d) & (e): The overall storage capacity required for central pool foodgrains in the country is about 650 Lakh Metric Tonnes (LMT). Against this, the total storage capacity available with Food Corporation of India (FCI), Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) and State Agencies (both owned and hired capacity), is 851.54 LMT (as on 31.12.2018) comprising 724.79 LMT in covered godowns and 126.75 LMT in Cover and Plinth (CAP) storage.

Besides, Government is implementing Private Entrepreneurship Guarantee (PEG) Scheme and has taken up construction of godowns and Steel Silos.
