452. DR. BANSHILAL MAHATO:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of refugees who came to India from Burma and Bangladesh after their partition and the places where these refugees have been rehabilitated, State-wise/place-wise;

(b) whether any measures have been taken by the States or the Union Government to help the family of refugees, who come from Burma and Bangladesh, to earn their livelihood;

(c) if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether the Government is aware that out of these refugees, the economic condition of several families is not so good and they are facing lots of difficulties in taking care of their families;

(e) if so, whether the Government has formulated any scheme keeping in view the said situations; and

(f) if so, the details thereof and the success achieved in this regard ?
