(a) whether Government is planning to put a cap on the tuition fees of Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government is incorporated a provision in the draft rules under new IIM Act to put a condition on the tuition fee charged by IIMs;

(d) if so, whether IIMs Management have expressed concern about this provision;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) whether the Government would revisit the draft rules and alter this provision and if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?
