MOU ON ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS

600. SHRIMATI VASANTHI M.:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether India has raised concerns before signing a Memorandum of Understanding with the UK over the return of illegal immigrants;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether India is concerned that a large number of Indians can be sent back without humanitarian considerations and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether there are nearly 40,000 illegal Indian immigrants in different parts of Europe and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]

- (a) to (c) No MoU on return of illegal immigrants has been signed with UK after the last MoU signed in 2004 expired in 2014.
- (d) Government of India is not in possession of data regarding illegal Indian immigrants in different parts of Europe.
