- (a) whether the Government proposes to allocate funds from the Universal Service Obligation Fund to mobile companies in remote areas in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the allocation made from the said fund to various companies during the last three years; and
- (d) the state-wise number of villages equipped with phone facilities?

- (a), (b) & (c) Subsidies are provided to mobile companies for mobile connectivity in inaccessible, rural and remote areas of the country including North Eastern Region, Left Wing Extremism Affected areas, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF). Details of subsidy disbursed to various mobile companies from USOF under different projects during the last three years is enclosed as **Annexure-A**.
- (d) The State-wise number of villages, equipped with phone facilities under the USOF is enclosed as **Annexure-B**.
