SETTING UP OF NEW TV AND RADIO CHANNELS

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to setup new TV and Radio channels in the State of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) the details of how such TV and Radio channels will be managed and operated;
- (c) whether the Government also proposes to extend the coverage of Doordarshan and All India Radio in the newly formed districts of Telangana State; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Prasar Bharati has informed that they have an approved scheme of setting up of AIR FM transmitters with studio at Nellore and relay station at 8 places in the State of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Details are given in **Annexure-1 & 2**.

Doordarshan

Doordarshan is already operating DD Channels from Telangana and Andhra Pradesh states as per details below:-

- (i) DD Yadagiri (Telangana)
- (ii) DD Saptagiri (Andhra Pradesh)

(c) & (d) All India Radio:

The State of Telangana already has 15 transmitters (MW-2, SW-1 & FM-12) installed at 11 places having coverage of about 99% of the area and 99% of the total population. Details are given in **Annexure-3**.

Doordarshan:

All the areas of the country (including Telangana State), have been provided with multi-channel TV coverage through Doordarshan's free-to-air DTH service. DTH signals can be received anywhere in the country (including all the districts of Telangana State) with the help of small sized dish receive units. All the 24X7 Doordarshan channels including "DD Yadagiri" channel originating from Telangana are available on DTH Platform.
