- (c) whether the RBI guidelines restricts the use of Indian currency for purchases of meals, etc. on international flights;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Ministry has taken up this issue with the concerned Airlines as well as Ministry of Finance;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (c) & (d):No Madam. Indian currency may be used for purchase of meals etc in international flights provided extant guidelines of Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) are complies with.
- (e) to (g): No Madam. M/s IndiGo has however, taken up the matter with Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in December 2017 for increase of permissible limits under FEMA.
