PROMOTION OF TOURISM IN KERALA

74. SHRI N.K. PREMACHANDRAN: SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposals for the development and promotion of tourism in the State of Kerala and if so, the details thereof along with the status of such proposals;
- (b) whether the Government has sanctioned any projects for the Malabar region of the State and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of growth of tourism sector in the country during the last four years along with the funds sanctioned for various tourism projects, State-wise including Kerala;
- (d) whether the Government has taken note of the advisory/alert issued by some countries to their citizens regarding their visit to India especially Kerala and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (e) whether the Government has initiated action to make a tourist friendly climate in Kerala and if so, the details thereof along with the initiatives taken by the Government to promote tourism in Kerala?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K.J. ALPHONS)

(a) and (b): The Ministry of Tourism under the schemes of Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD (Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive) provides Central Financial Assistance to the State Governments/Union Territory (UT) Administrations for development of tourism infrastructure in the country.

Submission of project proposals by the State Governments/UT Administrations under the above schemes is a continuous process. The projects for development are identified in consultation with the State Governments/UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed projects reports, adherence to relevant scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier. Based on the above criteria, the Ministry has sanctioned following projects in Kerala including the project for Malabar region: -

(d): The Ministry of Tourism is aware of advisory/alerts issued by foreign countries to their citizens regarding their visits to India. To address this issue, Overseas offices of the Ministry carries out regular interaction/ engagements with overseas tour operators, travel agents, opinion makers, media and consumer, to keep them updated about the ground situation in the country with an objective of reassuring them regarding travel to India.

(e): For creating conducive environment for tourists, the Ministry has implemented facilities of E-Visa, WiFi connectivity at tourist destinations, Web based public delivery system, 24X7 helpline service, Safety and Security, Cleanliness at the tourist destinations in the country including Kerala. For Promotion of Tourism, the Ministry undertakes several promotional activities in the domestic and international markets for promotion of the varied tourism products and destinations of the country including Kerala. As part of its marketing/promotional activities, the Ministry produces publicity material and collaterals in English and foreign languages, annually releases print, electronic and online media campaigns in important and potential markets overseas and within the country under the 'Incredible India' brandline. Promotions are also undertaken through the website and Social Media accounts of the Ministry.
