- (a) whether the Government is implementing the schemes associated with Delhi-Mumbai, Chennai-Bengaluru and other industrial corridors in the country and if so, the details thereof and the number of locations/cities being developed under them, corridor-wise;
- (b) the details of the projects approved under the said corridors and the name of the countries/investors who have agreed to provide financial assistance and as well as the amount of financial assistance provided by them so far, corridor-wise;
- (c) the progress made in approval and completion of the project under the said corridor and the current status thereof, corridor-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has received representations/proposals from public representatives and various parts of the country to include more cities under the said corridors; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government thereto?

- (a): Government of India through National Industrial Corridor Development and Implementation Trust (NICDIT) is implementing the following industrial corridor projects:

**(b) & (c):** The projects are being implemented by the project specific joint venture SPVs of Govt. of India (represented through NICDIT) and respective State Govts/State Agencies. No financial assistance has been provided to these SPVs by any foreign country/investor. The corridor-wise status of each of the industrial corridor is at **Annexure-A**.

#### Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC) Project:

Perspective plan for the overall DMIC Corridor has been completed. At present, DMICDC is developing following greenfield smart cities of DMIC Project for which master plans have been prepared:

The construction activities are in advance stage at the following locations:

- Activation area for Dholera Special Investment Region in Gujarat admeasuring 22.5 sq. kms;
- Phase-1 of Shendra Bidkin Industrial Area in Maharashtra admeasuring 18.55 sq. kms;
- Integrated Industrial Township Project at Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh admeasuring 747.5 acres;
- Integrated Industrial Township Project at Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh admeasuring approx. 1100 acres.

The process of land allotment has also been initiated. Total of 57 plots has been allotted at above mentioned locations. Apart from the above highlighted node/city level projects, following standalone projects have also been approved by Govt. of India as part of phase-1 development of DMIC Project:

- Freight Villages at Nangal Chaudhary, Dist. Mahendragarh in Haryana and at Dadri, Uttar Pradesh;
- Bhimnath Dholera Rail Link Project in Gujarat and Mass Rapid Transit System (MRTS) projects in Gujarat and Haryana;
- Greenfield International Airport Projects at Dholera, Gujarat and Bhiwadi, Rajasthan

### **Amritsar Kolkata Industrial Corridor (AKIC) Project:**

- a) Perspective Plan for the overall AKIC Corridor has been completed;
- b) One (01) Integrated Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) site has been finalized in each State for further;
- c) The detailed master planning and preliminary engineering activities are underway for IMC site at West Bengal (Raghunathpur) where 2483 acres of land is available with the State Govt.

### **Chennai Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC) Project:**

- a) Perspective plan for the overall corridor has been completed and planning and development works are going on for following nodes:-
  - Krishnapatnam, Andhra Pradesh
  - Tumakuru, Karnataka
- b) For Krishnapatnam node in Andhra Pradesh, project SPV has been incorporated and detailed master planning and preliminary engineering activities are being finalized.
- c) For Tumakuru node in Karnataka, project SPV has been incorporated and detailed master planning and preliminary engineering activities are underway.

### **Vizag-Chennai Industrial Corridor (VCIC) Project:**

- Envisaged as Phase-I of East Coast Economic Corridor linking Kolkata-Chennai – Tuticorin;
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has prepared the Concept Development Plan (CDP) and the nodes identified for development are as under:
  - (a) Visakhapatnam (6628 acres)
  - (b) Machilipatnam (15543 acres)
  - (c) Donakonda (17117 acres)
  - (d) Chittoor (26730 acres)

### **Bengaluru Mumbai Economic Corridor (BMEC) Project:**

Perspective Plan has been completed for the overall BMEC Project.
